MANAGERS REPORT:

All vehicles are up and running.

Fuel sales so far for April 2010 are 243.2 gallons and for the year so far, have been 2655.6 gallons. Fuel sales since we took over the system are 25,195.9 gallons.

Due to the attempted B&Es in the area, I am in the process of compiling an email list of the hangar owners here at the airport. This list is 50% complete.

We are currently looking at changing our insurance coverage here at the airport.

At the last meeting I was asked to bring water and pop back to the airport. I stocked a case of water and four six-packs of pop. As of today we have sold all but three pops and most of the water and have only received \$17.00 for this. We should have \$21.00 just for the pop and then what ever people put in for the water. Someone is still not paying for this.

A new schedule of events has been posted.

The taxiway rehab is scheduled for May 10th to June 10th.

The last weekend of June the United States Air Force inspection team will be evaluating The Michigan Wing of the Civil Air Patrol here at our airport.

The Civil Air Patrol squadron here at the airport is now up to 34 members (23 seniors and 11 cadets).

Last Thursday evening the Air Force reported an ELT (Emergency Locator Transmitter) going off in the southern half of Michigan. Two air teams and three ground teams searched the southern part of the state all night. Then on Friday members from our squadron at the airport were called out and found and disabled the ELT in the local area. A local pilot at his private landing strip had just installed the ELT in an airplane that he is in the process of building. He did not realize that it was in the "ON" position. This was very nice in that it was our squadron's first actual search and rescue mission that they were called out on and they will be credited with a "Find".

This coming Tuesday morning at 10:00 AM we will be having the MDOT Pre-Construction meeting on the taxiway rehab.
