**New Business:**

- **September Fly-In:** The September Fly-In is scheduled for Sunday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, from 8:30am to 12noon.
  - Ken and Pat Weber have a computer breakdown of necessary jobs and volunteers needed for each one (see attachment):
  - Rita: face painting and things for kids; also supplying workers with lime green 'staff' shirts for the day;
  - Steve: contacting military for recruiting booths; it's a go;
  - Brent: fingerprinting/Firehouse; also checking out with local officials placement of signs on M-21 the day of the Fly-In; Young Ford and Honda will let us use their electronic signs on the day of the FlyIn;
  - Mary: made up small flyers to be handed out with bills to customers at Crosswinds Café; will also check out Clowns for the day; commercial pilot plane ride (will AOPA membership allow this?); she will also make up flyer to send around the state;
  - Lance Little to do press release;
  - Tim H: Young Eagles & pilot volunteers; (also warbirds?);
  - Ken and Pat: vendor recruitment;
  - Tim M: tables and chairs;
  - Plane Parkers: Bob Hoschner to head up (?) with Nick, Gary, and Larry to help (?);
  - Menu: eggs, sausage, pancakes, cheesy potatoes, coffee, OJ; Cost will be \$7/person.

- Bob Hoschner's hanger is a go for the food; we need to arrange help to clean and set it up;

We will need to help out with teaching the boys/girls aviation related lessons twice a month. In exchange we get young people enthusiastic about aviation here at the airport. They will help with the Fly-In also.
